

CONSUMERS ENERGY SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

What is the Consumers Energy Scholarship Program?

The Consumers Energy Scholarship Program is designed to encourage and recognize the achievements of the children of our members.

This recognition will be in the form of scholarships to assist with their college education.

How much is the scholarship?

The Consumers Energy Scholarship Program will award two \$1000.00 scholarships to children of our members. The scholarship must be used for educational costs, and the student must enter college in the fall of the school year for which the scholarship is given. Checks will be made payable to the school, and will be distributed by our office.

Who is eligible to receive the scholarship?

Dependent children of cooperative members are eligible who are **high school seniors**. The applicant must be a student who planning to enroll in a full-time graduate or undergraduate course of study at an accredited two-year or four-year college, university, or vocational/technical school.

How are the recipients selected?

Awards are based on the following criteria: grade-point average, work experience, participation in school and community activities, a statement by the student explaining his/her educational and career goals, and a written recommendation by a third party.

How can I apply?

To apply, you must complete the required criteria and the scholarship application, which can be obtained at the Cooperative office or on our website: www.consumersenergy.coop – click on the Programs and Services tab, then click on Scholarships in the index. Click on application download.. The applicant is responsible for submitting all necessary information to apply for the scholarship.
